This 70 hour training course in multisensory language instruction (Orton-Gillingham approach with Wilson® materials) is offered to volunteers who commit to provide 60 free, one-on-one tutoring sessions to low-income students in our service area. While our training costs are over \$600 per trainee, we ask that you pay only \$200 to minimally cover the cost of your books and materials, which you keep. Limited scholarship funds are available. Teachers completing the training are eligible for 6 CEUs. (Note: If you do **not** intend to serve as a volunteer Augustine tutor in western North Carolina, you may take the training if there is space and you pay the full \$600 tuition.)

Make checks payable to Literacy Council of Buncombe County with “Augustine Training Tuition” on the memo line. **Return this form, the background information release, and your check at your earliest convenience.** Payment is due by June 15, 2012. Should you withdraw from the course after June 15 but before July 1, ½ of your payment is refundable. No refunds can be made after July 1.
