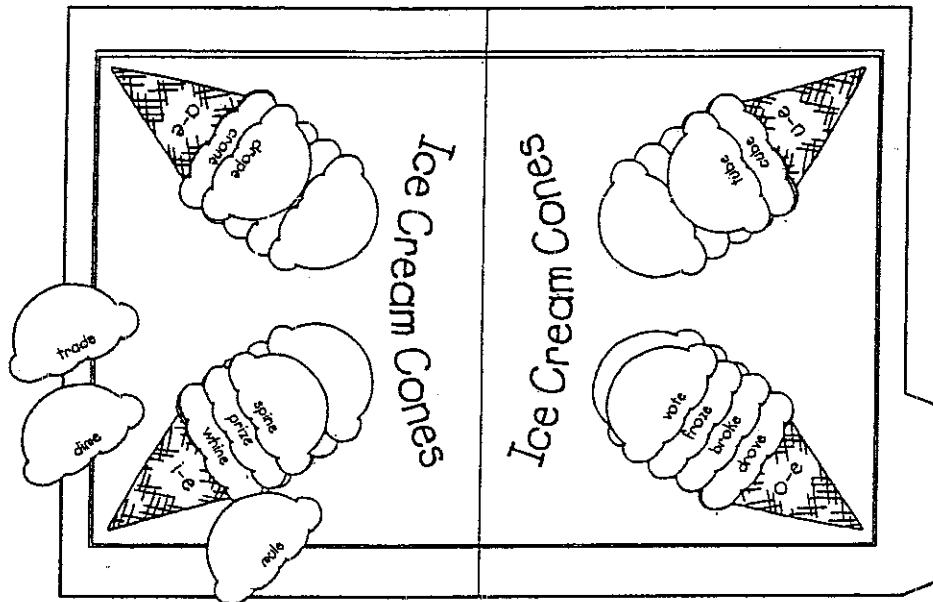


# 19. Ice Cream Cones

## Ice Cream Cones

(Vowel-Consonant-e)



### To Play (4 players):

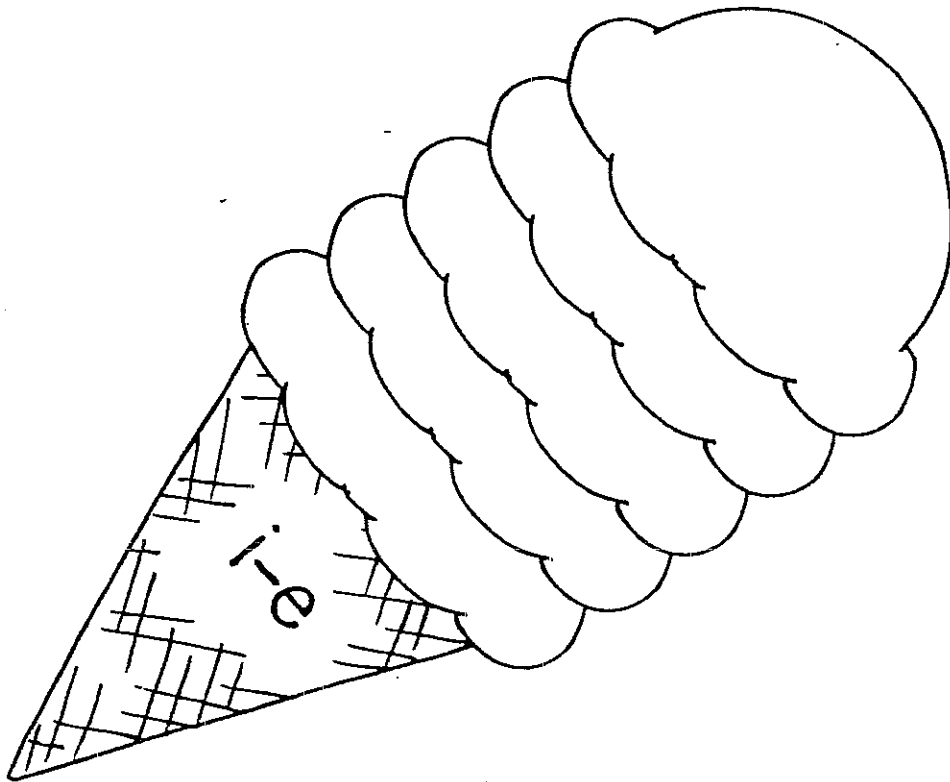
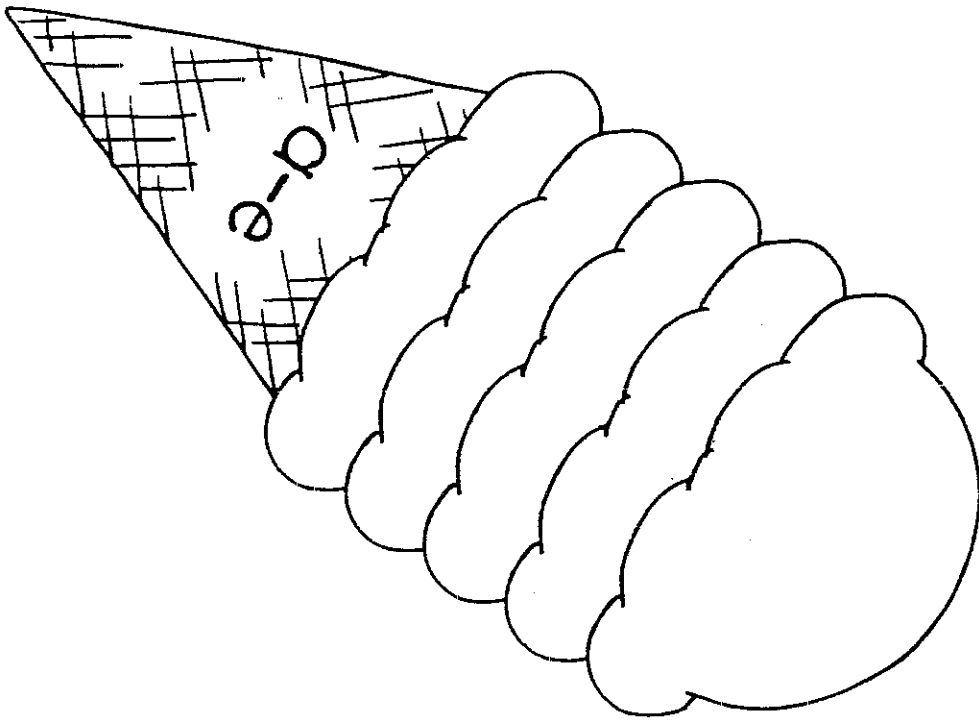
Put the ice cream scoop word cards face down in the playing area in rows. Each player chooses an ice cream cone for play: a-e, i-e, o-e, or u-e. Each player in turn picks up an ice cream scoop word card and checks the vowel-consonant-e pattern. If it is the pattern on his/her cone, the player may read the word and place it on the cone. If it is not, the player puts the scoop back in the row. Players layer their scoops so that each word is exposed. The first player to match 5 scoops to his/her cone is the winner.

### To Make:

Duplicate the board game setup twice and the ice cream scoops once. Glue the ice cream scoops on to oak tag. Color and laminate if desired. Cut out and store in a zip-lock bag. Trim the board game setup and glue to the inside of a file folder. Duplicate the game directions and label, and cut out. Glue the label to the file folder tab. Glue the "To Play" directions to the front of the file folder. Glue a clasp manila envelope to the back of the file folder. Store the ice cream scoops in the envelope.
