

Come to VOWEL VALLEY and join the dogs for a ski race!



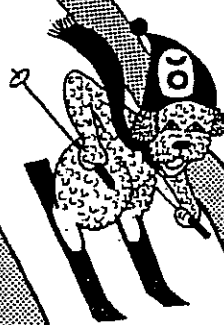
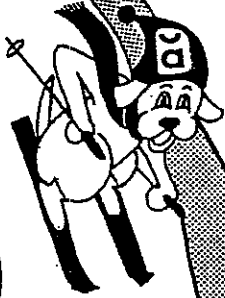
YOU WILL NEED : a gameboard (on page 43)
 50 game cards (on page 44)
 1 announcer
 5 ski racers

Pick a ski trail. And...
 Remember its vowel sound!

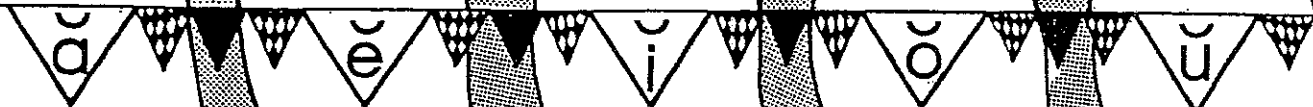
- ① Look at the gameboard. The race begins where you see the dogs. Each racer will ski down a different vowel trail with one of the dogs.
- ② Cut out the game cards. Put them in a pile, face down.
- ③ Announcer: Draw a game card. Read the word on it to the ski racers. Don't let the skiers see the word!
Ski Racers: Listen to the vowel sound of the word. The skier, whose trail has that vowel sound, will write the word on the first blank of his/her ski trail.
- ④ Announcer: Keep drawing and reading the word cards, one at a time. Give the skiers time to write each word.
Ski Racers: Keep moving down VOWEL VALLEY, writing only words that have the vowel sound of your ski trail.

The first skier to write TEN WORDS on a trail
WINS THE VOWEL VALLEY RACE!
